As a patriotic gesture from World War II his crew came up with 3 symbols they inlaid into the balloon's top: a heart, a peace sign & "Kilroy"...he peeks out during inflation and looks over his passengers in flight. The balloon is vertical striped alternating black and multicolors. He is a member of NOBPA. He's completed a 191 mile long jump attempt at 63 MPH in 3 hours 50 minutes on February 19, 2005.
